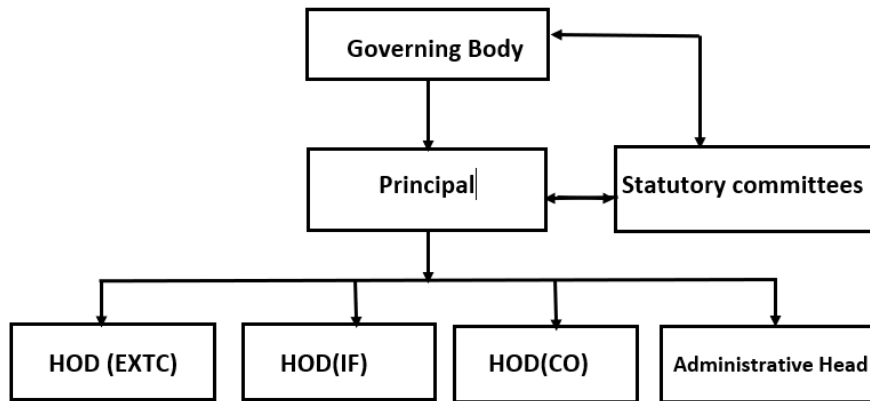

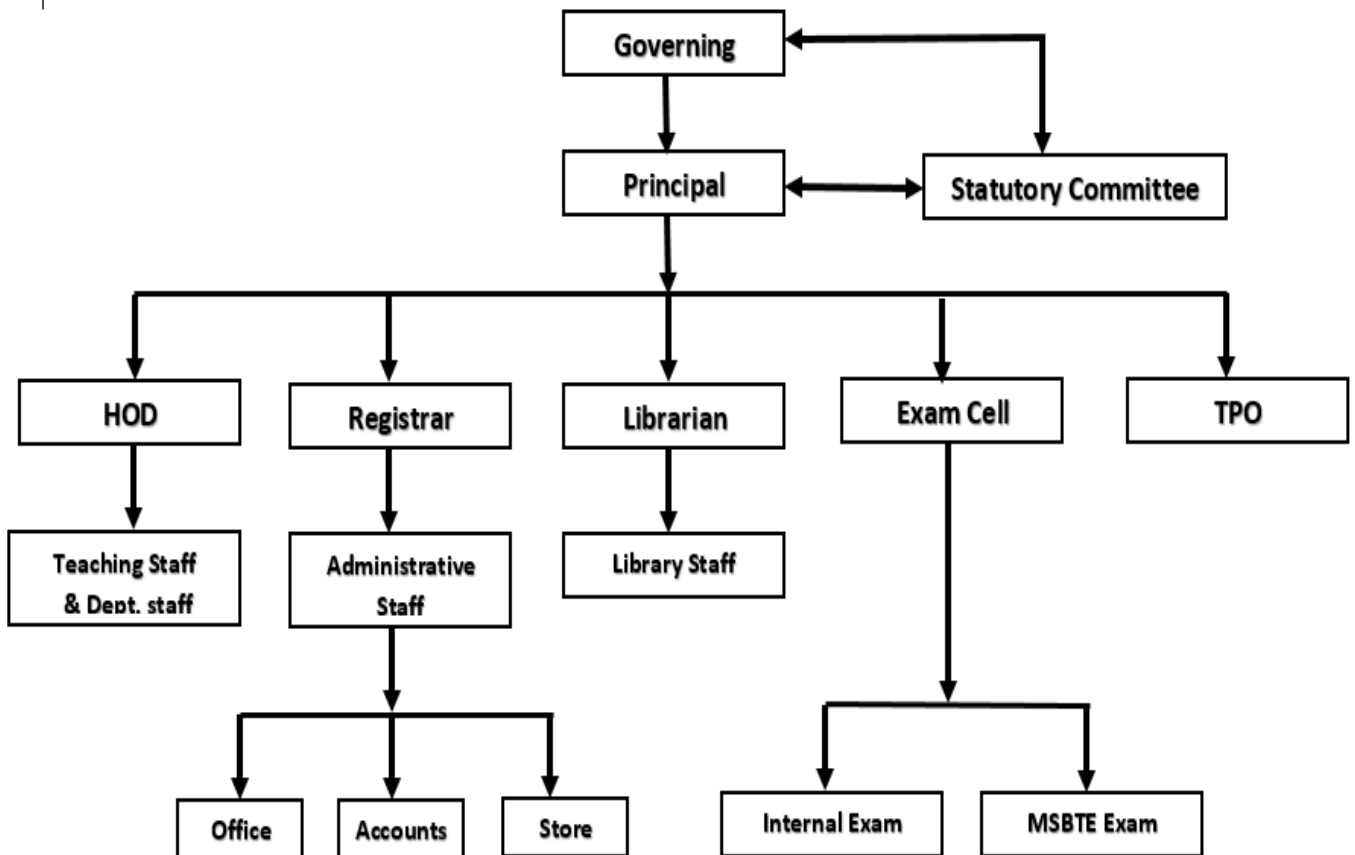

It also organizes regular health check-up camps to benefit the local community Institute maintains complete transparency in its functioning and promotes national consciousness and unity.
