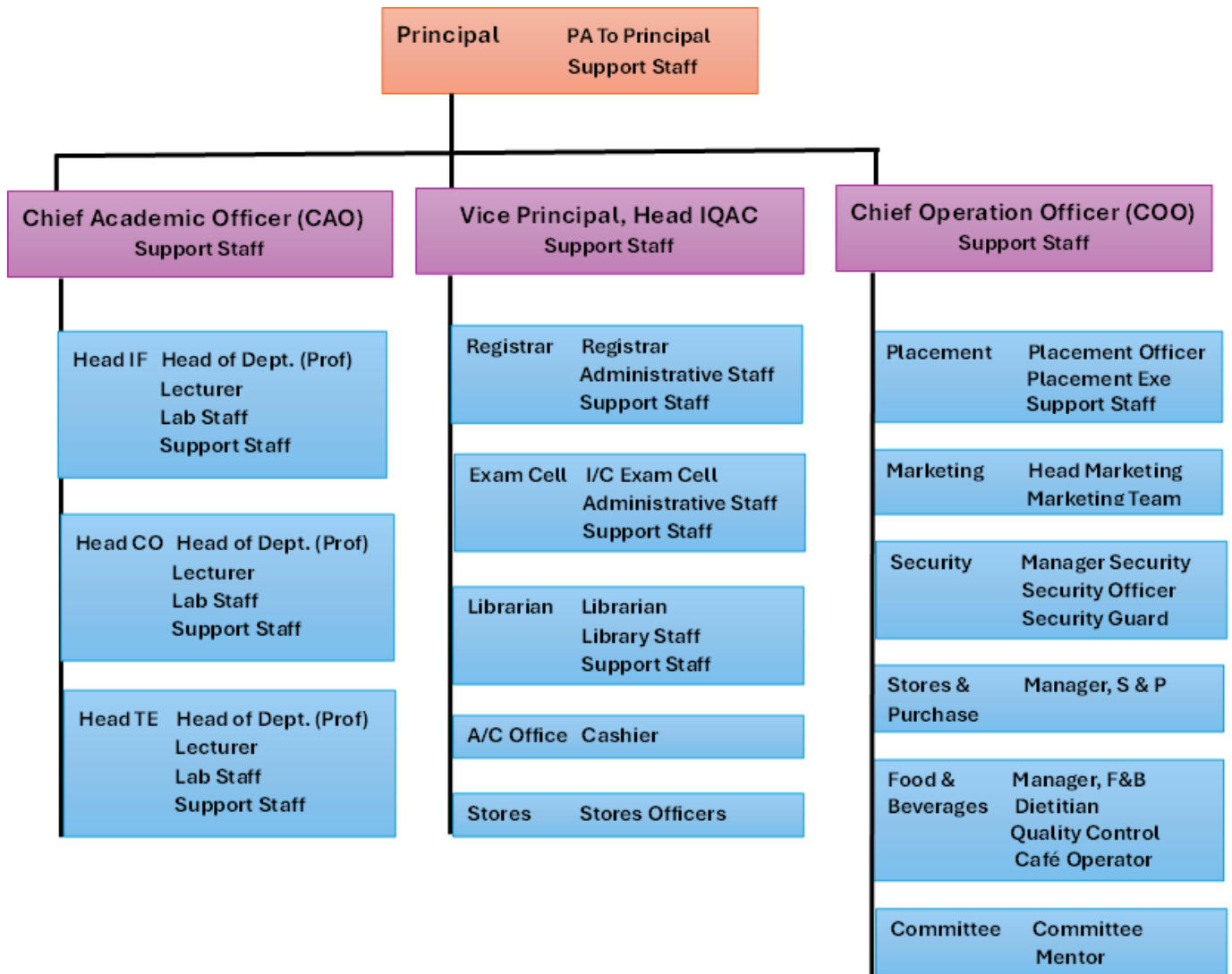

<p>Nature and Extent of involvement of Faculty and students in academic affairs/improvements</p>	<p>The Institute has a strategic plan for development where the goals and action plans are stated and are aligned with the Institutes Vision and Mission. The plans are developed by the Steering Committee in consultation with Principal and approved by the Governing Body.</p>
<p>Mechanism/ Norms and Procedure for democratic/ good Governance</p>	<p>The Principal is the academic & administrative head who monitors the overall functioning and has powers for academic, administrative, finance and institute's growth. For efficient functioning, the day to day administration is coordinated by HODs, academic administration. Training & Placements, Internships and Committee activities are coordinated by HODs of respective department. VP has decentralized its operations and has delegated authority at various levels to ensure good governance. There is a structured delegation of authority that encourages the academic leadership among the faculty within subject disciplines, peer groups through clusters and researchers through minor research proposals. Faculty are also empowered to decide academic/administrative/co- curricular/extra-curricular activities. Such decentralization strengthens administrative skills with professional responsibility and accountability that ensures broader participation in decision-making process.</p>
